LOOKING AND LISTENING
Vaughn Monroe to Open Five-Week Show Tonight

One new show and three re-turning productions mark the high lights of the TV dial tonight and there's lots of other important news along the channels. Let's take a peek at what is going on.

Vaughn Monroe, just signed by RCA to do all its commercial announcing for the fall season, will open a brand new show tonight at 7:30 (4) for five weeks. Each Tuesday and Thursday she'll sing some songs to the music of Richard Hayman's Orchestra, a long with The Tunesters, a vocal group. On Oct. 5 Dinah Shore returns to take over.

Jo Stafford, one of Long Beach's ex-residents, returns (2) at 6:45 and her husband, Paul Weston, again will be conducting the music. The Starlighters, a male quartet, will be featured on her weekly shows.

Then in the drama department we find a brand new Circle Theater with a new outlook and some extra spit and polish. The producers of the "Justice" series will lend their know-how to the program and this season they'll use top stories and stars. For instance, tonight we find Janet Blair and Tony Randall (Janet's Harvey Weiskot on "Mr. Peepers") portraying a young married couple who run into snarls and knots when she is selected to be "Mrs. Universe." Drama starts at 9:30 (4) and it sounds like fun.

On the more serious side there is "See It Now," the great news and special event show conducted by Edward R. Murrow (2) at 7:30 p. m. No one man has done so much toward making viewers aware of the news behind the news by the on-the-spot reporting. Fact is, "See It Now" topped 20 different awards last season, and that beats par for the course.

"Danger," formerly at 10 p. m., now shifts into the old "Suspense" fold of 9:30 (2) as will be discussed during "Search That Never Ends" on KHJ at a time. Tonight we find a young sailor trying to get train fare back home from a Reno gambling casino and is inveigled into staying for one day to act as a "shill" in the joint. This involves him in serious complications and, naturally, "Danger" is going on.

While on the drama side of the ledger we may as well peek in on young Pat Crowley, who stars with Jerome Courtland in a cute comedy called "Two" on the U. S. Steel Hour (7) at 9:30 p. m. She's a young wife with idealistic viewpoints about marriage but the erratic fortunes of an automatic laundry service owned by her husband have adverse effects on her ideas.

Nelson Case will host "Summer Theater" for the last time and next week his chore again will be taken by Gene Raymond for "Fireside." Later stars on the show in "Full Portrait" tonight (4) at 9 as a TV newscaster who checks on an old scrubwoman's death and finds many amazing facets to her life.

Our heat wave has affected Hollywood's writers, so tonight Father Day blows off steam when the thermometer hits the high spots. Seems there is no ice to chill his Rhine Wine and that makes "Life With Father" very difficult for the family (2) at 7.

When Archie almost sparks a little boy he is flattered by a much larger boy and becomes a hero (of sorts) during "Duffy's Tavern" (5) at 8 p. m.
