Kopycats salute Sullivan

Kopycat used to be a derogatory term... probably it still is among the younger set.

If you haven't met the Kopycats, I would suggest you take a look tonight on Channel 7 as "The ABC Comedy Hour Presents the Kopycats."

The show, which starts at 9:30, is a repeat (it originally aired last February), but it's my guess that many viewers will want to see it a second time.

The Kopycats, of course, are impersonators - Frank Gorshin, George Kirby, Marilyn Michaels, Rich Little, Charlie Callas and Joe Baker - and, in my opinion, they're great.

You may remember Sullivan; seems to me he had a show of his own one time, didn't he?

Jordan impersonates a number of Sullivan's "ancestors," including George Washington Sullivan, Chief Crazy Horse

Sullivan, Sullivan of Arabia, Zapata Sullivan and Rudolph Valentino Sullivan.

Kirby impersonates Archie Bunker and Miss Michaels his wife, Edith, in a take-off on "All in the Family."

In a golf course scene, Jordan plays Bing Crosby, Little is Fred MacMurray and Jack Benny, Gorshin impersonates Broderick Crawford and Rod Steiger, and Kirby is Rochester.

Miss Michaels, as Barbara Streisand and Fanny Brice, brings the music of "Funny Girl" to the show.

Baker and Little portray Abbott and Costello, and in another sketch Rich becomes David Brinkley interviewing Ed Sullivan, with Jordan playing Ed Sullivan Jr.

In a "Columbo" sketch, Gorshin is Peter Falk and Little becomes Joseph Cotton.

British impressionist Peter Goodwright does an impersonation of fellow countryman David Frost in the show, which originates from London.

Other stars impersonated include W. C. Fields,

Mae West, James Cagney, Charles Bickford and Richard Burton. Rich Little also impersonates famous stars paying tribute to Humphrey Bogart.

I don't know about you, but I could watch these Kats seven days a week. I think they're sensational.

IF YOU FEEL in the mood for something more serious on the tube, there's an hour-long documentary on population problems starting at 10 tonight on Channel 4. It's called "...

And Replenish the Earth" and it's narrated by actor Joseph Campanella, star of NBC's "The Bold Ones."

The film examines where America is heading in population growth and what life will be like by the end of the century.

A major portion of the program looks into the reasons why the birth rate has been declining in the United States.

Filed at various places across the country, the documentary shows an abortion being performed in a Los Angeles hospital; a visit to a "contraceptive boutique" in Chapel Hill, N.C.; a sex education class in session at Yale University; a vasectomy operation in Chicago; family planning projects at work in New Orleans and Baton Rouge, La., and a party at the home of Ellen Peck, author of "The Baby Trap."

The program is one of nearly 180 shows on the population problem being presented in the month of June by the five NBC-owned television stations. The stations are KNBC, Los Angeles; WNBC-TV, New York; WRC-TV, Washington, D.C., WMQ-
